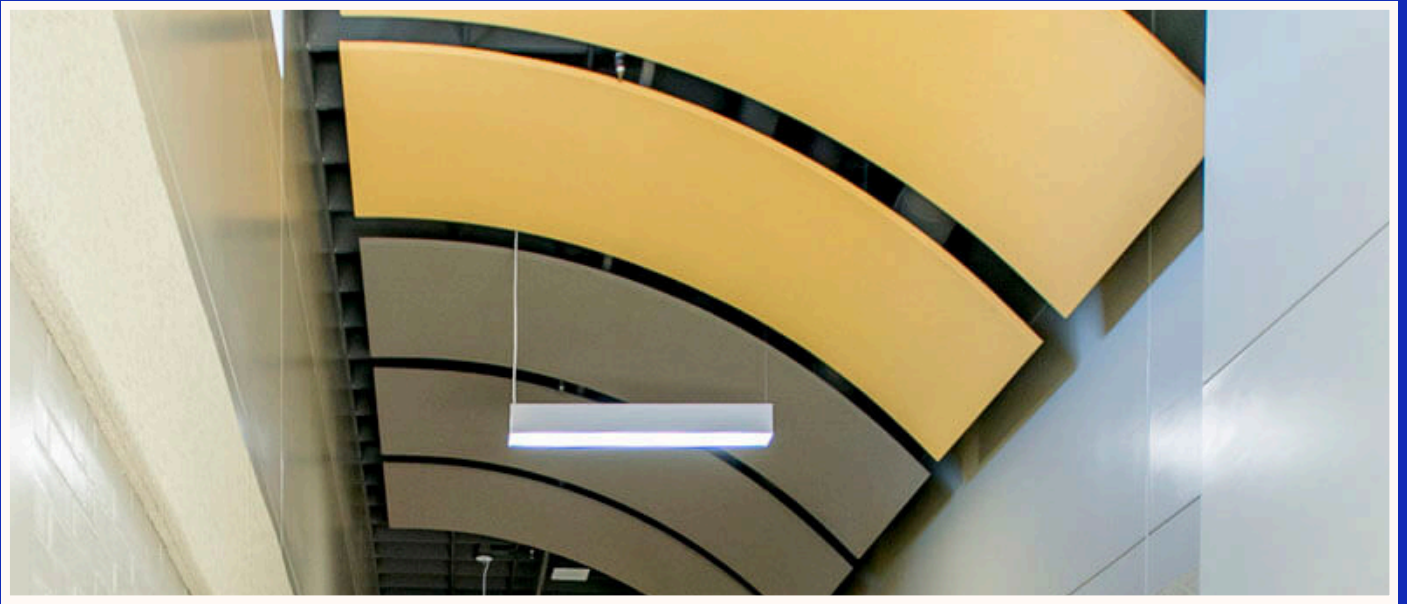




# ACOUSTIC CEILING CLOUDS

## Creative Acoustics for a Museum Exhibition Hall

**Client:** St. Augustine Modern Art Museum – St. Augustine, Florida

**Facility Type:** Open-concept art gallery and exhibition space

**Product Used:** Curved Acoustical Ceiling Clouds, Decorative Acoustic Panels, Acoustical Fabric

### CHALLENGES

The museum's open hall featured polished concrete floors, a glass dome ceiling, and art installations—creating a highly reflective space. Curators wanted to maintain the open visual concept while minimizing noise interference during tours, lectures, and multimedia exhibits.

## Solution

All Noise Control designed and installed curved acoustical ceiling clouds using fiberglass cores wrapped in high-quality acoustical fabric. These cloud panels were strategically suspended to absorb mid- and high-frequency reflections without disrupting the visual flow of the space. The design also doubled as a sculptural element.

## Outcome

- Dramatic improvement in acoustic comfort for guests and guides
  - Seamless integration into the visual theme of the space
  - Created zones of focused sound control within open areas
  - Allowed museum to host more audio-visual exhibits with minimal echo
