OVERVIEW

Performance Dance Center required a refined acoustic solution to manage sound between rehearsal studios, performance spaces, and adjacent common areas without compromising the beauty and openness of the facility. To achieve both acoustic control and visual appeal, All Noise Control installed the ANC-17 Acoustic Curtain system, a decorative acoustic curtain solution designed for attractive, people-focused environments.

The ANC-17 system incorporates elegant soundproof curtains, that provide effective noise management while enhancing the interior aesthetic. These sound curtains helped Performance Dance Center create flexible acoustic zones using noise filtering curtains supporting both creative expression and acoustic comfort.

CHALLENGES

Simultaneous dance classes, rehearsals, and private coaching sessions produced overlapping sound that disrupted instruction and concentration. Performance Dance Center needed noise reducing curtains that blended seamlessly into the studio design. The solution required visually appealing sound blocking drapes that could be easily opened or closed as schedules changed.

SOLUTION:

All Noise Control installed ANC-17 acoustic curtains as decorative soundproof curtains suitable for performance and studio environments. The system combined sound insulating curtains to effectively control airborne noise while maintaining an elegant appearance.

The ANC-17 sound isolation curtain system utilized sound resistant curtains to separate studio spaces without permanent walls that reduced reverberation and improved sound clarity throughout the center.
